What's Growing?

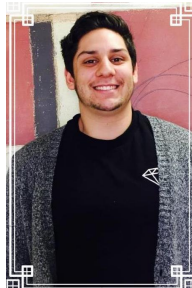
Consumers worked hard and gave their best efforts to provide natural grown vegetables for our culinary classes. Last month we had lettuce and tomatoes. What should we grow next season?



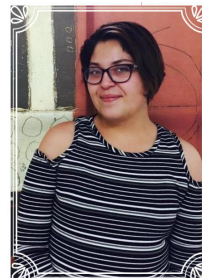
Nature Museum Center
